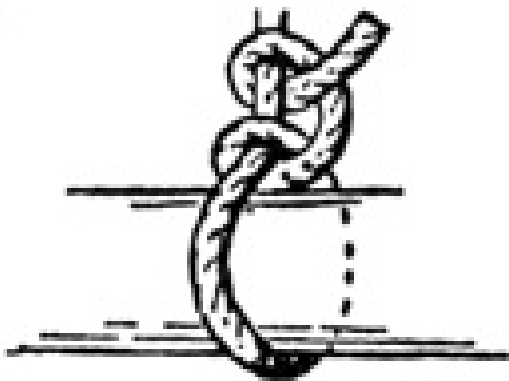
SQUARE KNOT



USES:

THE “JOINING KNOT” IS USED TO JOIN TWO ROPES TOGETHER & THE 1ST KNOT LEARNED UPON JOINING FOR RANK OF “SCOUT”

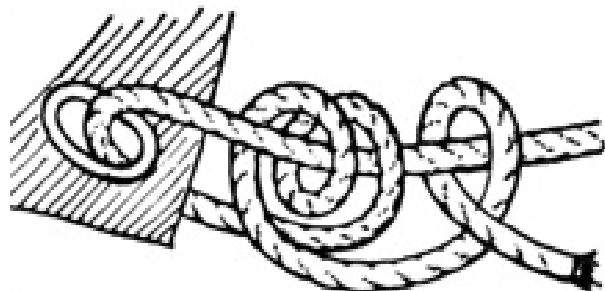
TWO HALF HITCHES



USES:

TO ATTACH A ROPE TO THE POLE, TREE OR TARP END OF A SHELTER (PARTICULARLY WHEN THERE IS NO ATTACH POINT OR GROMMET) ...BECAUSE ... WHEN CINCHED UP, THE HARDER WIND & WEATHER PULLS AT THE TARP OR POLE, THE TIGHTER THE KNOT GRIPS IT.

TAUT LINE HITCH



USES:

TO ATTACH THE OTHER END (STAKE, STUMP OR OTHER TREE) OF ROPE SECURING SHELTER, RIDGE-LINE, CLOTHES LINE OR ANY OTHER LINE THAT YOU WANT TO MAKE TAUT (TIGHT) ... CAN BE USED AT GROMMET END OF TARP (AS WELL AS A BOWLINE) IF NOT CONCERNED ABOUT PULLING OUT OF TARP.
